Dear Registered Voter:

As a registered voter, you are eligible to obtain an absent voter (AV) ballot for any election. Michigan Election Law requires two things in order meet the requirements for AV voting. One is we need an application for an AV ballot on file in the clerk's office before we are able to send an AV ballot. And two, you must choose one of the six approved reasons as to why you want to vote by AV ballot. Those reasons are:

- age 60 years old or older
- unable to vote without assistance at the polls
- expecting to be out of town on election day
- in jail awaiting arraignment or trial
- unable to attend the polls due to religious reasons
- appointed to work as an election inspector in a precinct outside of your precinct of residence.

If you would like to receive an AV ballot application for every election going forward, we can add your name to our permanent AV application list. If this appeals to you, please complete the response below and return this letter to the clerk's office at city hall. If you should then decide to vote at the polls for any election, you can just ignore the application when you get it and vote at the polls instead.
